Chile	1891	Troops	Marine clash with nationalist rebels

Cuba	1958	Command operation	200,000 marines sent
Cuba	1962	Nuclear threat, naval	Blockade during missile crisis, near war with Soviet Union
Panama	1964	Troops	Protesters clear to signal travel return
Dominican Republic	1965-66	Troops, bombing	Marines land during election campaign
Guatemala	1966-67	Command operation	Seven weeks intervene against rebels
Cuba	1971	Command operation	US backed coup ousted democratically elected Marxist president
El Salvador	1978-82	Command operation	US backs, over rights and political use, soldiers' brutality in hostage deals, long term result: 70,000 murdered and destruction of popular movement
Nicaragua	1981-90	Command operation, naval	200,000 marines sent, 100,000 killed
Honduras	1984-90	Troops	Americans help build bases near borders
Guatemala	1984-86	Troops, bombing	Intervene four years after revolution
Bahamas	1987	Troops	Army units reach to control region
Panama	1989	Troops, bombing	Political government ousted by 27,000 soldiers, bodies arrested, 2000 killed
Philippines	1989-91	Naval, naval	Blockade against military government; troops return President unable to office three years after coup
Guatemala	1991	Command operation	Blockade attempt to remove the corrupt president Jorge Serrano
Haiti	2004	Troops	Removal of democratically elected President Aristide; troops occupy military
Honduras	2009	Command operation	Support for coup that removed president Manuel Zelaya
