Trump: Great Strides Made in 'Ridiculous' Afghan War

Whenever President Trump is dealing with NATO issues, there is always the question of whether Trump is going to praise NATO as the greatest thing since sliced bread, mock them as a relic of the past, or somehow manage to do both at once.

Meeting NATO Secretary General Jens Stoltenberg on Tuesday, Trump played up the pledges for increased military spending, while pushing for even more. He <u>also cheered the</u> "great strides" made in Afghanistan militarily by NATO, while terming the war 'ridiculous.'
