We will not know, although suspicions persist, that the virus came out of a laboratory, "coincidentally" in the midst of a fierce international trade war, in which it is intended to

weaken emerging "enemy" powers and also equal to supposed allies. A good understander with few words is enough.

But we return to Africa with another question: Could it be that now someone wants to turn it into an incubator of the SARS-CoV-2 virus, as they have done with other diseases to do experiments?

It would be cruel, but we live in an increasingly inhuman and unscrupulous world of not a few who only think about making money, even if it is in the worst way.

Precisely today there are large emporiums interested in the Covid-19 not ending to multiply their millionaire profits already obtained thanks to that ailment.
