Chile: Indecencies that shame

Indeed, this diaspora caused many problems for the host countries, especially those who were even poorer than us. It is a fact that among those who left our territory there were many who were not necessarily political exiles, just as there are countless cases of those who dedicated themselves to crimes in the most diverse ways. However, we know that many of these situations were faced without stridency so as not to provoke animosity or xenophobic expressions among the host peoples. Thousands of Chileans, in addition, stayed permanently abroad while in those who insisted on returning there were those who even received financing and support for it. Even to grant them resources that could be useful for their labor and family reintegration in Chile.

We have already referred to the enormous contribution made by thousands of immigrants who in recent years have settled throughout our territory, although we must really regret that among them have come criminals, drug traffickers and others who today have our security in check. In agriculture, mining and so many other activities, their contribution has been invaluable and, in general, paid below what Chilean workers receive for the same activities. When the Businessman President invites Venezuelans to come to Chile, he undoubtedly works with the calculation that they could be of great use to the bosses' world that employed them. Although, as we say, many thugs have crept in who are certainly severely disrupting our coexistence.

It is regrettable that it has fallen to a government that declares itself left-wing to confront, now, the decision to militarize our borders to prevent the access of new immigrants, while enacting laws that give more powers to the police to repress offenders, imprison them and expel abroad those it calls illegal immigrants. Authorities greatly pressured by a situation of insecurity that is very exacerbated by the media and in which the political right as well as the economic one see the possibility of destabilizing the democratic regime. In addition to encouraging populisms and caudillos that could perfectly lead to power a new dictator or tyrant like the one we already had.

It is clear that in all these last years our democratic vocation has been very much in doubt and that what prospers most in the population is once again the desire for a strong or authoritarian government. In forgetting, of course, that the "order" imposed by the military and de facto governments will bring us thousands of victims, hundreds of thousands of unemployed, in addition to the transfer abroad of a good part of our natural resources, forests, waters, deposits and practically all of our national companies.

After 17 years of civic-military dictatorship, the number of poor exceeded 40 percent, wage income was well below international standards, and ownership of health and education systems had been dominated by foreign investors and speculators. Those who also became owners of the pension system that, with their AFPs, are responsible for the miserable pensions that today affect more than 80 percent of retirees, unless they have belonged to the Armed Forces and police.

What has been implemented by the post-dictatorship governments has not managed to correct the abysmal social inequality and the scandalous concentration of wealth, scourges

that explain, above all the causes that are falsely imputed, the development of popular unrest, social explosions, criminality itself and the consolidation of drug trafficking.

To this, it is also evident that the dictatorship and the governments that succeeded it are responsible for the high levels of corruption that can be seen today in politics and public institutions, phenomena that also encourage violence, the leniency of the judicial system and the shameless assault on the national treasury and the pockets of consumers consummated by the high military and police officers. as by business collusions. To the extent that today thousands of fraudulent medical licenses are discovered, charged to the public health system, accredited by unscrupulous doctors, while the private entities of the isapres in the midst of the economic crisis continue to assign millionaire profits.

The unfortunate thing is that those who govern us and the parties that are supposed to watch over social prosperity fall in love with the fallacies of the right and its media, especially television. In that the few representatives of the people will exercise their task completely tied by the political agreements already negotiated and agreed by the political leaderships and approved by a National Congress that completely lacks legitimacy and prestige. Behind closed doors, of

course, as everything is done within the democratic order and the rule of law that both rightists and leftists presume.

But the shamelessness is so high that a journalist is recently expelled from a press conference by an officer present for the slip that this outstanding professional had of calling a carabinero "paco", a term that is not very reverent but that has always been the nickname that the people commonly use to refer to the "guardians of order" in our country.
