The main news in the media capitalists is the arrest of a 21-year-old member of the Guard National Air in Massachusetts for the leak of about 100 documents state "classified". They were allegedly shared in a chat for players on the social media platform Discord and later shared by Russians on Telegram. The First Class Aviator Jack Teixeira has been charged with violating the Espionage Act and He faces 10 years in prison on one charge, but more could follow. Charges.

He has shown white supremacist tendencies and anti-Semites. If the allegations are true, it is possible that Teixeira He was just showing his fellow players what he

believed I could do: take out classified "intelligence" reports, place them on the kitchen countertop and photograph them for publication in Discord.



President Fred Hampton, leader of the Black Panther Party of Chicago, killed in 1969 in a police raid instigated by COINTELPRO. For more than a century the FBI has engaged in espionage and far worse against black revolutionaries and other progressives.

The Espionage Act was passed by Congress in 1917, shortly after after the United States entered World War I. Only It has occasionally been used to accuse individuals, mainly those accused of spying for the former Soviet Union. The most important case famously, and the only one in which the death penalty was imposed, was against Ethel and Julius Rosenberg. These two members of the Communist Party of The United States was falsely accused of passing the formula to the USSR. of the atomic bomb.

Espionage *per se* – euphemistically referred to as "intelligence gathering" when carried out by the capitalist state – is not a crime for the US government, which maintains a huge domestic and international spying apparatus, including the FBI and CIA. From COINTELPRO to the overthrow of democratically elected governments around the world, these "legitimate" government bodies perform acts far worse than mere espionage. The full cost of these operations, which the working class finances with its taxes, is not even in the public domain.

Espionage only violates the 1917 Act when it is allegedly carried out Corporal in the name of an "enemy". But in this case the "enemy" is a online gaming chat group, Thug Shaker Central. The New York Times, Spokesman for large companies, he was the first to investigate these Leaks. The newspaper turned its findings over to the federal government. Why?
