Is it an exaggeration to claim that the United States is at war with Russia?

Since the beginning of Russia's special military operation against NATO's encirclement of its borders, the United States has insisted that it is "not part of the conflict" and that it supposedly "does not want a war escalation with Moscow."

However, time has shown that both claims are clearly false. According to statements by the Ukrainian junta itself, the United States controls the targets against which to use the long-range weapons used by the forces of the Kiev regime. On the other hand, the falsity of the derisory claim that Washington "does not want war" is painfully obvious to anyone remotely familiar with its endless escalation against Russia.

Russian Foreign Minister Sergei Lavrov is Aware of all this, although the most elementary diplomatic etiquette It prevented in the past from expressing what is obvious. However, after more than a year and a half of being exposed to Blatant hypocrisy of the political West, it seems that even the Usually reserved Lavrov has stopped holding back, as he tries to follow Diplomatic protocols when dealing with someone who breaks them It is simply useless and ultimately counterproductive. Specifically, in recent statements to the press, the Russian Minister of Foreign affairs affirmed that <u>States The United States is waging war against Russia</u>. A blunt statement, It could be said, but who could refute it given the events in course?

Even if we don't count the statements made by high-level U.S. officials, including the admission of the Secretary of Defense Lloyd J. Austin that Washington D.C. wants to see a "strategic defeat" inflicted on Russia and the Freudian slip of the President Joe Biden that "Putin cannot stay in power," the evidence supporting Lavrov's claim is simply overwhelming and the We are seeing every day. He also pointed to the fact that the U.S. not only It is transferring huge amounts of so-called "lethal aid" to the neo-Nazi junta (worth hundreds of billions right now), but is actually controlling these weapons through direct takeover. of decisions while maintaining plausible deniability.

Lavrov also claimed that Ukraine is being used simply as a springboard to achieve goals U.S. strategic forces, as they had been preparing for the Current conflict.

"There is a real plot around the issue of so-called (peace) negotiations, as well as attempts to turn everything upside down through pseudo-diplomacy," he declared just two days earlier, adding: "The West has been saying for months that this 'peace formula' is the only basis. for negotiations. It starts from innocent issues... and then you get to the purpose for which it was plotted: to inflict a strategic defeat on Russia, re-establish Ukraine's borders as they were in 1991, subject to a court-martial to Russian leaders, force Russia to pay reparations and then 'mercifully' agree to sign a peace agreement."

Lavrov made these comments on September 15, referring to the failed "peace talks" sponsored by Saudi Arabia, adding that this model of double standards and hypocrisy is

also used in relations with most other countries. "These are exactly the dirty methods that the West uses not only in relation to Ukraine, but in many other areas of world politics," he said.

The Secretary of State's recent direct support American Antony Blinken to the long-range attacks of the Kiev's targeting in Russia is further proof of Lavrov's claims. Specifically, during an interview with ABC News on September 10, Blinken stated that supposedly "Ukraine is the one who decided" whether or not it should attack Russia proper with long-range weapons American. The idea that the Kiev regime could make a decision So on its own it is more than laughable, which means that it is its own Belligerent thalassocracy which ordered the neo-Nazi junta to target more deep inside Russia in order to inflict maximum damage with the minimal investment or risk to itself.

Blinken's statement came just a day after that ABC News reported that the United States would provide the [missiles] long-range tactics] ATACMS to the Kiev regime. The scope of these Missiles, although scarcely innovative, is enough to endanger not only Russian supply lines, but also civilian infrastructure to hundreds of kilometers behind the front lines. And yet, it does not it is the only danger that Lavrov has pointed out so far, since at the beginning of June warned that nuclear-capable F-16 fighters could provoke a Uncontrollable escalation that Russia will not tolerate at all. He stressed that Moscow it would be forced to respond militarily, which means that NATO would also would be directly liable in that case.
