Analysis of the rise of the far right in Italy





The journalist and writer Alba Sidera (Girona, 1979), based in Rome since 2007, has specialized in the study of European far-right movements and contemporary Italian politics, issues that are the subject of "Persistent Fascism" (Textos contextatarios, 2023).

Originally published in Catalan in 2020 and now updated in a translation by Paloma Farré, this book reveals the disturbing drift of the transalpine country in recent times, the result of a global process that continues to cast ominous shadows over many regions of Europe. As he points out in his foreword Miquel Ramos, since the appearance of the previous version of the book, The situation has only gotten worse, with Giorgia's accession Meloni to power and the right assuming the xenophobic postulates of the far right. It must also be said that the ideologues The reactionaries have learned a great deal, and they are now striving to appear so that the new fascism, without renouncing completely to the old man, tries to distance himself from him and conquer the masses with a friendly face.



The far right is already in power in several countries in Europe and in others it could do so shortly, so that that understanding the dynamics of the ongoing process is urgent extraordinary. This is what Alba Sidera is working on in this work.

Other Common phobias target feminism and LGBTI rights. With regard to the economy, they can be found from protectionist to interventionists, even ultra-liberals.

Silvio Berlusconi (1936-2023) It has an essential role to play in the whitewashing of fascism in the Italy. Media mogul threatened by multiple causes He devised a master plan to seize power and get rid of them, while presenting himself as nothing less than than as a champion of the fight against corruption. Here's how in In 1994 he won the elections and formed a government, relying on the neo-fascists of the Italian Social Movement and the populists of the Northern League, champions of xenophobia. In a country where the antifascism was considered a hallmark, this was a overturn. A few years later, Berlusconi had to watch as the Northern League, metamorphosed in the League, led by Matteo Salvini and taking advantage of the strategies of his good friend, Marine Le Pen and her Front National, he won over the electorate that had been so loyal to the *former Cavaliere*.

Initially, he bet heavily on Salvini in Italy, and when he fell out of favor because of his Russophile connections and his management of the pandemic, by Giorgia Meloni, the new winner of the 2022 elections.

The book also provides data alarming questions about how things are going in other European scenarios.
