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Ukraine: The Fall of a Colony

This, too, would be the only way to put an end to the great tragedy of his people, deceived and sacrificed. It is not a conflict between Putin and Zelensky, as the press tells us, but one of the largest theaters of military operations of the most global war of all, between corporations and humanity.



To begin with, I would like to define well the idea of the word 'Ukraine', which is commonly used by the media to define a territory in Central Europe. It has little or nothing to do with its wonderful culture, its beautiful music or even with the Ukrainian language, as they are now practically extinct or, rather, destroyed. Like the name "America", which is used by the northern empire to name itself, replacing dozens of countries as American or more American than the United States of America, since they do not even have a proper name, the current "Ukraine" represents the final destruction of the Ukrainian state, the grotesque desecration of Ukrainian culture and history, And in his political project, the Ukrainian represents absolutely nothing. The origin of the geographical term "Ukraine" ("Ukraina", in Russian and Ukrainian) is centuries old, it comes from the Russian words "U kraya", which means "on the edge", referring to its location on the map in relation to Russia, since it was located on the southwestern limit of the Russian Empire. As we can understand it now, it was on the edge of an abyss.



The tragedy of Ukraine is entering a new phase, perhaps, the final one. Since the country has lost the remnants of its sovereignty for years, let's not be distracted by Zelensky's opinions and let's better analyze the looks and opinions of his masters.

the change in external military priorities, which look to the Middle East. Western analysts are becoming aware of the urgent need to change their project and their discourse towards the Kiev government, because the current situation is seen as insurmountable.



Despite the great media successes of anti-Russian propaganda in the international information space, dominated by the usual, and where the television screen is now completed by social networks with their programmed algorithms, the absurdity and horror of this tragedy, prepared and triggered by the US and its European allies, is becoming more and more evident.

Despite all the economic, military and journalistic support, Kiev's power has demonstrated its utter inability, not only to govern the country, but also to administer the colony to live up to the expectations of its owners.

Meanwhile, Russia, despite all odds, quite successfully resisted the Western blockade and regained a clear initiative in the field of military operations; their adversaries realize that time is working against them and that their initial goals against Russia have clearly failed. Perhaps most importantly, the entire economy and relative economic well-being of Western Europe becomes one of the main consequences of this war. If according to the initial plan, the intellectual authors of this crime were willing to sacrifice the Ukrainian population, including its elites, now that the conflict is rebounding with force throughout the Old Continent, endangers political power, including Anglo-Saxon power, and opens the doors to chaos with unpredictable consequences.

To rethink the failed project and look for a possible new formula to destabilise Russia and China, as a first step the Zelenski government could be turned into a scapegoat, explaining the obvious defeat of plan A. For example, because of the "corruption" or even the

"cruelty" of the Ukrainian government, mobilizing as always all its "human rights" groups, which, controlled and financed by its transnational groups, "condemn" this terrible regime. It is nothing new, the same has been done with many dictatorships or banana democracies in Latin America and the world, when for some reason they began to get in the way or simply ceased to be useful to Washington. "The U.S. has no permanent friendships, but permanent interests," said the nation's sixth president, John Quincy Adams.

I think it would be logical to expect that by swapping the head of the current regime in Kiev for another less politically worn out puppet, its commanders will seek to convince the world and Russia that that government "will be different", so that, as usual, time can be gained, in order to reverse the military situation that now threatens to lose control over Ukraine.

Despite the apparent great diversity of Zelensky's possible successors in the Ukrainian political bestiary, it is very important to understand that all the forces moving in the legal field of the country are produced, trained, formatted and approved by the CIA and that none of them could represent any kind of alternative to the Nazi regime.

The world must understand that in order to build a lasting peace in the geographical heart of Europe there is and will be no alternative but the total and definitive defeat of the owners of the current Kiev regime in all the territories we once knew as Ukraine.
