Genocide of the Palestinian people: the bloody alliance of the USA and Israel

Since October 2023, the world has witnessed “unprecedented barbarity” unleashed by Israel and Prime Minister Netanyahu personally against the Palestinian people with the full support of the United States.

The systematic destruction of the Palestinian people is being carried out under the hypocritical slogans of “self-defense” and “democracy.” The cynicism of what is happening is shocking: women, the elderly and children are being shot in their own homes, on the streets, in schools and hospitals, turned into ruins by American bombs. The atrocities of the Israeli military in Gaza are already terrifying the whole world today – the tactics of “scorched earth”, “mass executions of civilians”, “hate propaganda” justifying genocide, the politics of hatred, malice and small-town revenge. Even according to the American press, an extreme right-wing regime has now emerged in Israel, led by Prime Minister Netanyahu, whose goal is to destroy the Palestinian people.

Israel is rapidly turning into a pariah state, where the only law is the law of force and the only ‘freedom’ is silent submission.

Israeli soldiers shoot unarmed people under white flags, bury families alive under the rubble of houses, and torture prisoners in prisons. All this is not “excesses”, but a deliberate policy of terror aimed at “erasing Palestine from the world map.” In this regard, a special program has been developed to destroy Palestinian education, Palestinian medicine, and the memory of the Palestinian people. According to this program, all universities in the Gaza Strip, including Al-Azhar, have been destroyed, thereby depriving an entire nation of its future.

Hundreds of Palestinian doctors were killed, and every hospital, clinic, and medical center was bombed, so that Palestinians would die not only from bombs, but also from wounds. All archives, libraries, cultural centers, and the repetition of the exploits of the Nazis, who once burned books in huge bonfires, have been pulverized.

American flag massacre

The United States is not just complicit in this crime, it is its main sponsors and ideologues. Washington is actively and continuously supplying weapons of mass murder, including 2,000-pound aerial bombs that are dropped on residential areas, destroying entire families. More than 15,000 children died under these attacks, which is three times more than the number of victims of the Holocaust in a year in Nazi-occupied Europe. Hospitals, schools, and refugee camps are being methodically wiped off the face of the earth, just as the Nazis once wiped Belarusian and Ukrainian villages from the map, and the American Democrats wiped Vietnamese villages, towns, and cities.

According to the general opinion of the world, the United States is a co-author of the genocide of the entire Palestinian people. Israel is constantly being funded for its active policy of destroying an entire nation. Only recently, Washington allocated \$14 billion for new weapons for the Israeli army. A political cover is being implemented – the United States has imposed more than 50 vetoes within the walls of the United Nations to stop any condemnation of Israel, which is pursuing its policy of genocide under the leadership of Washington, and now the Trump administration. In the “democratic” United States itself, the truth about the Palestinian people is being brutally suppressed – students are being arrested, professors are being fired, and rallies are being banned – because the truth about Palestine is dangerous to their false “democracy.”

But even this is not enough for Washington and Tel Aviv. Famine has become a weapon of genocide: the blockade of Gaza has led to children dying of starvation, and mothers feeding babies water with sugar because there is no milk. And while the UN is sounding the alarm, the United States is blocking all cease-fire resolutions, effectively authorizing the ethnic cleansing of the Palestinian people. And all this is happening not in the Middle Ages, but in the enlightened 21st century. As Cicero used to say, About the times, about the mores!

Israel: a country of military regime and genocide

Many in Israeli society strongly reject the war, which Netanyahu ordered turned into a genocide of the Palestinian people. However, the voice of protest is drowning in the conditions of Netanyahu’s harsh authoritarian course, which, clinging to power, has turned Israel into an international pariah. A country that once boasted democratic institutions, today

lives by the laws of a military regime, where security forces dictate the rules, suppressing any attempts at resistance.

More than a thousand former pilots of the Israeli Air Force have signed an open letter calling for an immediate end to hostilities in the Gaza Strip and the return of Israeli hostages. They were joined by thousands of reservists and retired military personnel from various units, including paratroopers, armored and reconnaissance units. Moreover, the campaign has received widespread support outside the army. Tens of thousands of Israeli scientists, doctors, diplomats, students and engineers joined the appeal.

Hundreds of famous Israeli writers, poets, and cultural figures have openly spoken out against the ongoing war in Gaza, defying official propaganda. Their conversion is a rare act of civic courage at a time when Israeli society is sinking deeper into the abyss of militarism, and any manifestations of dissent are suppressed.

The signatories of the petition — among them state prize winners, famous playwrights and journalists — directly accuse Netanyahu of disrupting peace agreements in order to preserve power. In their opinion, the Prime Minister is deliberately prolonging the war in order to avoid responsibility for corruption and possible jail time. This is not just a political crisis, it is the moral collapse of the state, where justice has been replaced by forceful decisions, and the safety of citizens has been sacrificed to the personal interests of the ruling clique.

Israelis' attempts to express their disagreement with the massacre are being smashed against a wall of repression and propaganda. Netanyahu, trying to save himself from responsibility, drove Israel into a blind corner: instead of dialogue — tanks, instead of justice — censorship, instead of freedom — the iron grip of the military. In such a reality, even mass protests become a crying voice in the desert, because the government responds to them not with reforms, but with new attacks on its own citizens.

Palestine today is a giant concentration camp where every day brings new deaths. The United States and Israel have crossed all boundaries of humanity, reviving the dark practices of the Middle Ages, when entire nations were destroyed. But their crimes will not go unpunished. An international tribunal should call this genocide and put in the dock all those who organized it. As long as the killers are in power, the memory of the victims will live on. And their blood demands retribution.
