Five ANA troops killed Suicide bomber hits ISAF convoy

Five soldiers of the Afghan National Army were killed and four more injured while performing security responsibilities in different regions of the country, the Ministry of Defence said Saturday. A press release issued by the Ministry of Defence, available with the Afghan Islamic Press, stated five ANA troops were killed four more injured in improvised explosive device blast and fire by the armed opponents in Ghazni, Paktiya, Kandahar and Badghis provinces over the past 24 hours. It added the security forces seized weapons and explosives in the offensives. The Taliban have not said anything in this regard till filling of this report. Meanwhile, a suicide car bomber attacked a NATO convoy in Afghanistan's eastern province of Nangarhar on Saturday, an official said. Foreign forces suffered no casualties in the attack. The incident took place on the Torkham-Jalalabad highway at around 10 am when the bomber detonated his explosives-laden car near the International Security Assistance Force convoy, the governor's spokesman said. Ahmad Zia Abdulzai said that they had yet to receive any information about casualties. Only the bomber was killed in the botched attack, said the provincial police spokesman, Hazrat Husain Mashriqiwal. A Taliban spokesman, Zabihullah Mujahid, claimed they had blown up a military vehicle of ISAF, killing six soldiers. But the NATO-led force rejected the claims as baseless, saying that none of the international soldiers was killed in the assault.
