At Least Four NATO Soldiers Killed in Afghanistan

At least four NATO soldiers were killed in Afghanistan in a series of bombing attacks over Sunday night and Monday, according to official statements. The nationalities of the slain soldiers were not immediately made available.



The deaths bring the total number killed so far in July to at least nine, an important number to keep track of in the wake of a <u>June that saw 103 NATO troops killed</u>, a record for the nearly nine year long war.

Indiscriminate bombing attacks across the nation today were also said to have killed at least seven civilians, another toll which has been rising at an alarming rate over the past several months.

Today's attacks were a deadly welcome to Gen. David Petraeus, who arrived in the nation late last week and formally assumed command of NATO forces in the nation at a ceremony yesterday. Petraeus <u>has vowed to win the increasingly disastrous war</u>, though he has also pledged not to change the failing strategy of his predecessor Gen. Stanley McChrystal.
