Red Sea, the second front

The conflict in Gaza that opened up after Hamas' armed incursion on October 7, an operation that clumsily provided excuses for the overflowing Zionist response, seems to be further and further away from abating.

It is in this context, where the extermination of Palestine has been in full swing since the beginning of November, to the sound of its *sarkha* or war cry "God is great, death to America, death to Israel, curse on the Jews and victory of Islam", the Yemeni movement *Ansarullah* (supporters of God) popularly known as Houthis after the name of their founder, Hussein Badreddin al-Houthi, who was killed in 2004 and succeeded by his son Abdul Malik al-Houthi, is giving a forceful response in support of his Gazan brothers,

attacking the boats that dare to transit the Red Sea, and particularly all those that are in any way linked to Israel.

Using drones, missiles and anti-ship ballistic missiles – the latter a truly astonishing novelty - operated from their territories, the *Houthis* have virtually closed the passage to and from the Suez Canal, a very high commercial traffic route with a fifteen percent of world trade. It is in this context and following *Resolution 2722 (2024)* of the *United Nations Security Council* (CoS), where the right to freedom of expression is defended. free navigation and condemns the *Houthi attacks*, less than twenty-four hours of that resolution, the United States, together with a group of addicted nations (United Kingdom, Australia, Bahrain, Canada and the United States) Netherlands) attacked resistance positions Yemeni on the night of Thursday the 11th.

At least 60 targets were reportedly attacked in more than a dozen locations, including the nation's capital Sana'a, the port city of Hodeidah, and the cities of Saada and Dhamar, using U.S. Navy and Royal Air fighter jets *Force*, plus ship-launched *Tomahawk* cruise missiles unidentified.

It's important at this critical time for safety of the Middle East, and when it looks like it could be hurtling towards a great regional conflict, consider how quickly United Nations resolutions are implemented, as in this case, when it comes to resolving in favor of of U.S. interests or its allies, as opposed to when *Israel* is targeted for its historic abuses against the people has been allowed to disregard eighteen (18) *United Nations* resolutions on the occupation of Palestinian territory, for which it has never been subject to sanctions.

According to the U.S. command, Thursday's overnight attack included radar systems, air defense and storage sites, and launching for one-way attacks on unmanned aerial systems, cruise missiles and ballistic missiles, the number not yet known of Yemeni casualties that have occurred.

Mohammed Abdulsala, the spokesman for the Yemeni resistance, reported that after the attacks by the Western coalition, they responded with actions against ships stationed in the Red Sea and vowed that the movement will continue attacking ships heading to Israel.

Meanwhile, U.S. President Joe Biden is doubling down on He insists that he is willing to authorize new attacks on Yemen if the *Houthi* attacks do not stop. For its part, Iran, like the Lebanese movement *Hezbollah*, which since the beginning of the latter conflict has had rocketry duels with the *Zionists*, they condemned attacks on Yemen.

Since December, naval units of the coalition of 22 nations, most of them only in name, of the "Operation Guardian of Prosperity" (OGP), also led by the United States and whose mission has been to protect shipping, have been stationed in the Red Sea.

While the OGP, so far, has been limited to intercepting drones and missiles without carrying out offensive actions, after the endorsement of *Resolution 2722* could change their actions.
