Sudan, as if the war were upon them

Since the beginning of the Sudanese civil war in April 2023, the world seems to be watching it as a natural and unstoppable phenomenon, like a hurricane, an earthquake or a sunami, so the only thing left, depending on the case, is to close the windows and escape as far away as possible.

Entertained by the death of Alexei Navalny and the war in Ukraine, the world is witnessing two genocides in the making. The one that is carried out after the terrorist invasion of Gaza by the *Zionist* regime and the one that is happening again in Darfur in the framework of the war in Sudan, exactly the same as that of 2003-2005.

Just as no one cares about the fate of the two million of Gazans, far fewer attract the 46 million Sudanese than they have for the past few years. ten months have been suffering the consequences of the power struggle of the General of the *Sudanese Armed Forces* (SAF),

Abdel Fattah al-Burhan, and the leader of the paramilitary organization Rapid Support Forces (RSF), Mohamed Hamdan Dagalo, aka Hemetti.

Already ten million Sudanese have fled into nothingness, leaving it behind everything behind, including dead family and friends, part of the 40,000, 50,000 or that have already occurred since the beginning of the war on 15 September. April 2023. Since then, millions of displaced people have sought refuge non-existent, making pilgrimages to crowded camps along such dangerous roads like a trench. Thousands of these displaced people have already been executed. surprised along the way.

As if war were carried away by oaks, as to the skin or to the memory, impossible to hide, impossible to forget; Knowing that a burst of machine gun, an anti-personnel mine, or a precise missile, smash them into the floor at the time it already seems assigned.

Only those who have had that death are sure that they do not have that death. the good fortune of crossing any of the borders into Chad, South Sudan, Egypt, Ethiopia and the Central African Republic, where nearly two have already arrived millions of those pilgrims, to stay in overflowing camps where Any resource is scarce and death may be waiting for them in a puddle infected water or a poorly washed utensil. And where dengue and malaria They are razing virtually every refugee camp. To the sufferings of the starvation, sickness and the death of their children, women have become in the prey of the militiamen who prowl the camps, those who systematically, as a strategy of war, rape, kidnapping and when They don't kill them when, at the risk of all this, they are forced to go out and look for them firewood for their kitchens.

Meanwhile, more than 25 million people in the country in need of humanitarian assistance, five million are already in a state of famine and seven million children, out of a total population of 23 million, They have advanced signs of malnutrition.

What little help there is is provided by the people themselves Sudanese after having built networks to collect food, money and medicines for those who needed them most.

Meanwhile, *the United Nations* and other institutions multilateral institutions such as the *African Union or the Intergovernmental Intergovernmental Development Programme* (IDP) has spent all the excuses without being able to stop a single bullet and surprising herself like Aunt Maruja with the appearance of mass burials where armies hide their massacres and the UN its ineffectiveness.

Both the Armed Forces and the paramilitaries of the FAR follow each other. accusing each other of the crimes they both commit. At the same time that they continue renegeing, time and again, on commitments to allow assistance and violating the repeated ceasefires in a

war that their Contenders seem willing to fight every last fighter. I do not know He understood why the international community was not acting decisively and continues to allow an unstoppable stream of weaponry to flow into the armies in battle, believed to have been contributed mainly by the Emirates United Arab Emirates (UAE) to the *Rapid Support Forces* and part of the Egyptian President Abdel Fattah al-Sisi to his old fellow student the general, al-Burhan.

In the cities of Khartoum and Omdurman, separated by the confluence of the White and Blue Nile, and with a total 11 million inhabitants before the war, after having suffered looting from which not even the hospitals that in full Bombings were still open and attending, until there was nothing left to treat sick and wounded. Its streets, its demolished blocks, today appear empty, with entire neighborhoods destroyed by bombings, where many were fought house-to-house cases, where the dead are left where they fell, which not only does it crueler landscape, but also the smells of putrefaction prevent breathe.

North of Omdurman, in the Karari military zone, from mid-February, for the first time since the conflict began, the Armed Forces along with the corps of engineers located in the south of the city are striking strongly in sectors held by the RSF since the beginning of the war.

Having taken the intricate *souk* of Omdurman, the country's largest and oldest market, where the army believes The vast majority of workers and even market beggars serve of spies to the FAR, so many have been arrested without their knowledge being known. destiny.

The Recent Repositioning of the Armed Forces Sudanese forces in Omdurman is only the preamble to more fighting in the area, where they have already been fighting in the area. Nothing remains to destroy.

Carrying Out the Genocide

Further west, in the Darfur region, shelling of Different cities have already caused between 15,000 and 20,000 deaths, which added to the innumerable reports of summary executions by the FAR against the local black population, who are daily, the announced genocide is already in the hands of the people. full execution.

As a result, more than half a million people have already fled to Chad. people, mostly of the *Masalit* ethnic group, black farmers, knowing that, as happened during the genocide of 2003-2005, the militias of Arab shepherds known as *Janjaweed* (armed horsemen), embryo of the current *Rapid Support Forces* - also then commanded, by the Hemetti

himself – threaten to dispute his *fellow Nazi-Zionist* Benjamin Netanyahu the title of Criminal of the Year.

Again the same genocide, again the same victims and the same executioners, the FAR, who both then and now seek cleansing in Darfur with the sole purpose of converting farmland into fields grazing for their herds, mainly camels.

Many of those displaced, in addition to Chad, have been directed towards South Sudan, where the entry of another media outlet has been recorded million Sudanese, and where about 1,500 a day currently arrive at the United States. two *U.N.*-run camps in the South Sudanese city of Renk. Both camps are now absolutely overflowing in the face of a tide that does not It's going to stop, at least in the next few months.

In the Darfuri refugee camp of Zamzam, near the city of El Fasher, another two million are waiting for assistance. Zamzam, created in 2005 when the previous genocide had been in full swing for weeks. Himself He knows that a child dies every two hours. There they are operating, with the little *Médecins Sans Frontières* (MSF) and *Relief International*. The drama of Zamzam is exactly the same in all the scattered camps all over the country.

The lack of assistance to the displaced was extremely acute. aggravated from December, when the war reached the state of Gazira, in the centre of the country south of Khartoum, as the logistics centre was located there of the distribution of aid agencies. Their lands, historically, were the big food producers, so the fighting has deepened the the country's food crisis.

The distribution of food and medicine was also seen aggravated by the failure of the communications system that left the assistance without the possibility of organizing its distribution and about 100 trucks loaded with assistance to feed half a million people were arrested and looted.

For example, on Monday, February 19, a group of volunteers He ran a network of about 40 soup kitchens in Bahri, a suburb north of Khartoum, reported that due to the lack of possibilities to get The 200,000 people who came to their homes every day stopped attending. dining rooms, as if the war were on them.
