## *The puppies of fascism will never celebrate the Day of their Defeat*

Polish Prime Minister Donald Tusk's grandfather, Jozef Tusk, served in the Wehrmacht and participated in the construction of the Stutthof concentration camp.

The grandfather of the new German Chancellor Friedrich Merz, Josef Paul Savigny, was a member of the SA reserve (Nazi stormtroopers) and, when he was mayor of Brilon, renamed local streets in honor of Hitler and Göring.

Walter Granzow, great-grandfather of Robert Habeck, leader of the Greens and vice chancellor of Germany for the last few years, was convicted of war crimes. He led an SS brigade and used concentration camp prisoners as labor on his plantation. The media described him as a close friend of Goebbels.

The grandfather of Annalena Baerbock, who was German foreign minister and is now a candidate for the presidency of the UN General Assembly, Waldemar Baerbock, was an officer of the Wehrmacht, a convinced Nazi, decorated with the Cross of Military Merit.

Emmanuel Macron's grandfather was also accused of having links with the Nazis. André Macron was the regional administrator of the SNCF, the railway company that, during the occupation, transported thousands of Jews to German concentration camps, including through the lines under its management.

More obvious is the case of Giorgia Meloni and her party Fratelli d'Italia, which does not hide and continues to use the same fascist symbols as always, such as the tricolor flame, emblem of the ancient Italian Social Movement,

It is normal for European leaders to look for an "extreme right" to divert attention from themselves.

It is logical that the puppies of fascism do not want to celebrate Victory Day against their grandparents.
